## **OBJECTIVES**

## AS AMENDED NOVEMBER 13, 2014

The Canadian Association of Petroleum Landmen shall be a non-profit organization, the objectives of which shall be:

- to inspire and maintain a high standard of professional conduct on the part of its members;
- to further the education of its members in matters pertaining to the oil and gas industry;
- to promote fellowship and co-operation among its members through the activities of the Association;
- to encourage its members to volunteer to participate in the Association through service on committees and the management of the activities of the Association;
- to provide timely and relevant news, information and resources (other than financial support) that will assist its members in adjusting to the business cycles associated with the oil and gas industry;
- to promote appreciation for and public understanding of the work performed by its members:
- to engage in public and governmental relations with respect to matters directly related to the work of its members in the oil and gas industry;

- to promote education and training in petroleum land management by establishing and
  maintaining scholarship funds for the benefit of students at any accredited college or
  university which offers a program in petroleum land management and by offering to
  assist any accredited college or university in developing or maintaining a program in
  petroleum land management, where such program would be of benefit to the Association;
- to assist other associations in the oil and gas industry in the furtherance of their activities, where such activities are of benefit to the Association; and
- to fund, promote and establish activities and services that enhance the value of membership in the Association and promote the role of the Petroleum Landman.
